Introduction

Thanks for downloading RAF Mona for FS9; this simple airfield has been built to accompany Birdman's RAF Valley (beta version at time of release). The beta version of Valley is available from the ACG forum in the Valley forum.

The airfield is very space as it is in real life, only buildings within the airfield perimeter have been added.

Installation

Auto Installation

Run the ACG_RAF_Mona.exe and follow the onscreen instructions.

Manual Installation

You can if you wish manually install the airfield, if you are daring enough to attempt this then I don't think you need install instructions, LOL

Important Information

Overrun Barriers

The Overrun Barrier in FS9 work according to wind direction. Setting the wind direction for a Rwy22 approach will set the Overrun Barrier up at Rwy04 and down at Rwy22. Setting the wind direction for a Rwy04 approach the barrier will be up at Rwy22 and down at Rwy04. No Crash is enabled on the overrun barriers so you can fly through them.

Note One: Due to a bug in FS9 the wind direction must be set either before starting a flight or when the flight is loaded. If you forget the barriers will not be visible.

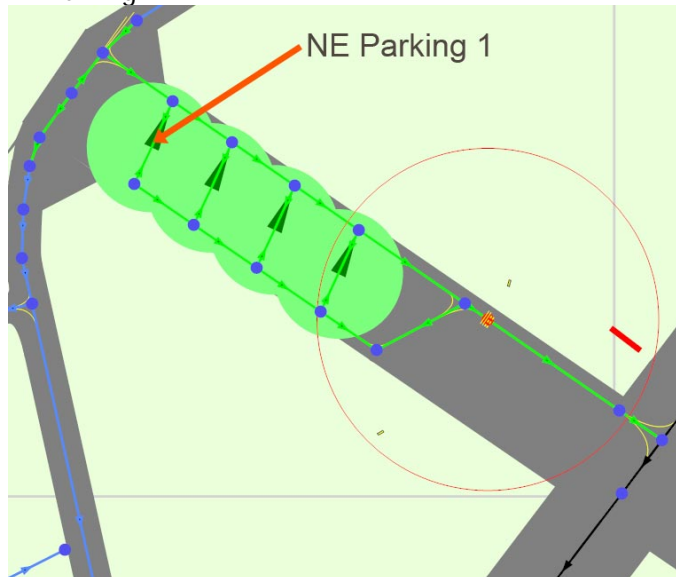
Note Two: In some cases (unfathomably to myself, LOL) the barrier will not show when the wind is set (usually between 127 and 187 degrees) if this occurs set the wind to another direction out of this range.



User Ground Service Equipment

If you feel like landing your Hawk or other RAF aircraft at Mona you can taxi to NE Parking 1, then tune your Comm frequency to 118.40, this will enable a group of GSE equipment to service your aircraft. (Only for looks though they don't really service your aircraft, LOL) If you can't find the parking spot or ATC directs you to another, you can tune in the 118.40 frequency once you have left the runway, this will help you know where you are going.

Once the Comm frequency is switched you will see this ground equipment.



Simply detune the frequency or contact Mona Ground/Radio and the GSE will disappear.

AI Aircraft

I have not included any AI aircraft with RAF Mona. I would highly recommend MAIW Hawk packages available from the MAIW website. <http://www.militaryaiworks.com/> these already have flightplans (Valley and Mona) for Hawk touch and go's and if you download RAF Valley Beta it will make the RAF Valley/Mona experience much more pleasing.
